She had the distinction of being charter member in three Presbyterian Churches—Cross Roads Church, located in Dayton, N. J.; Williamsburg Church, at Williams-

burg, Va., and York River Church, five miles from Williamsburg. She is survived by two daughters, Miss Grace E. Schenck, of Williamsburg, and Mrs. A. E. Slater, of Richmond, Va. Indeed, a mother of Israel has fallen.
