SMALL CATCHES

Both Manager Ballagh of the Columbia River Packers' Association and Jas. H. Sheldon report that the run of fish is very small, in fact there are no fish. No reason is given for the falling off in the run, as when the fishing season opened very good catches were made. Mr. Sheldon states that he is getting a few shad, whereas several years ago it was no uncommon occurrence for one man to go up Willamette slough and bring back several tons of shad. Mr. Sheldon states that if any fisherman would now bring in five hundred pounds he is afraid he would die of heart failure. He attributes the scarcity of shad due to the fact that several years ago, when the shad were spawning, fishermen would go up the slough and with their nets, which reached the bottom of the river, would destroy the spawn and also catch the shad roe by the thousands. Hence the scarcity.
