

**COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS**

St. Helens, Oregon, Jan. 19, 1920. The City Council met on the above date in the City Hall in regular session. All officers present. The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved. Reports: The Marshal reported at some of the owners of property on Hemlock street were repairing the sidewalk. Councilman Wheeler reported on about the street lights at West Helens still being out of commission, and asked if there could not be provided adequate police protection that part of the city. The same was discussed but no action taken. Councilman Wheeler also reported the cost of erecting a building adding the city dock, 50x100 feet, at cost of about \$2500.00 which was discussed at some length, and was over for further consideration. In the matter of collecting dock-levy over the city dock, this matter was taken up and discussed, and it being reported that no collections had been received from the contractors of the School building, and others, it was decided that the amounts due be retained and bills sent demanding payment of the same at the rate of cents per ton. Petitions were received from persons who had signed remonstrance for the improvement of West street, and it appearing they had signed the same under representations of the facts, also asking they were signing for the improvement of said street, asked their names be removed from remonstrance, after examination of the petitioners and remonstrators before, and it appearing that 168 of them were for the improvement and 121 against it was decided that the Council proceed with the improvement of said street. The matter of dances given by Columbia Club for a rebate of the license paid the City, was taken up and discussed and the request denied. The following claims against the City were read and on motion made and carried, ordered paid by warrants to the City Treasurer: Claim of Harvey Hooper for work on sewer, \$39.00. Claim of Ben Pierce for work on sewer, \$27.00. Claim of J. B. Godfrey for work in sewer, \$4.00. Application was received from Terry to install an oil service on Oak Street near the building on Lot 11 Block 27, also to erect said building. Permission granted.

Application of Thos. Roy for repair and alteration of building located on the Strand granted; application of A. J. Kelley to erect a building, repair another building, and tear down another building, was granted in West St. Helens.

In the matter of the connections of residences with the sewers, a motion was made and carried that all dwellings within the provision of the ordinance for the connection with sewers, that the owners of the real property be notified to make such connection immediately.

No further business appearing, on motion made and carried the meeting adjourned.
