A Court-Plaster Caution.

A doctor warns people to use court plaster with more precaution than is generally done. Court plaster is only of use in the case of clean cut wounds, in which there is but just one mark to show where the knife or other sharp instrument cut its path. For lacerations or contused wounds, or for punctured wounds, caused by the tissues being somewhat deeply penetrated, court plaster should never be used. Where there is a possibility of poison or infection being present in the wounds, or which are characterized while healing by any increase whatever in tissue substance, the employment of court plaster should be strictly prohibited, for it will almost invariably cause festering and an increase of mischief. It may be confidently expected by the users of all court plas-

ters, whether "medicated" or not, that if they are applied to a broken surface in which there is any inflammation, however slight, a process of decomposition and ulceration will be set up, which will disappear only with the disappearance of the plaster itself.—Boston Post.
