If farmers were thoroughly posted on the subject of churning there would be no demand for a churn to bring butter in less time than from 20 to 40 minutes. For years up-to-date dairymen have known this to be true and have governed themselves accordingly in selecting and using a churn. Churns for which the principal claims made are that butter can be churned in from two to five minutes are constructed with internal devices, such as paddles, shafts and floats, all of which have a tendency to break the grain of the butter, while the churn of today that is endorsed by those who have a practical knowledge of butter-making has no inside fixtures. The two and five minute churns with their internal arrangements are not the kind farmers should use.

Tascherau & Hamilton, commission merchants, notify farmers of Central Washington to ship no more alfalfa to that market for the present, as it is overstocked.

Don't make them fat and lazy by over-feeding and then look for healthy hens and fertile eggs.

Ten to 15 hens often pay well where 25 to 30 are kept at actual loss.


