



CONDITION OF COTTON AND CORN CROP MUCH IMPROVED SINCE RAIN

Columbia, May 31.—Copious showers occurred over the eastern counties during the middle of the week and over the northwestern counties at the close, elsewhere the rains were light and scattered. Cotton and corn germination has consequently improved, and corn has withstood drought conditions considerably better than other crops. Grain is being harvested, and while oats and wheat have headed short and are poor to fair in some sections, the quantity and quality have exceeded expectations in many other localities. Tobacco has improved generally. Frost in the western portion continues to fall. General soaking rains are needed to check drought to germinate seed and to improve truck, gardens and pastures.


