#### Cattle.

There were more breeds of cattle represented this year, as the Agricultural College brought down Guernseys, Holsteins and Herefords, and Uncle John Seeley made a fine show with Shorthorns as did W. C. Winder with Jerseys. Olsen and Clayton Land Co. showed some good Herefords, not, however, in show shape. Mitchell had some good Jerseys and Uncle Jake Smith was on hand with the Ayrshires.

More attention should be paid to getting in more exhibitors and more attention should be paid by the owners to the condition of the stock. Poor, lean, long legged cattle are no credit to anyone.

#### Shorthorns.

Mr. Seeley's well balanced herd took all the prizes offered for this breed. This herd is brought out in good form every year and would be a credit at any fair. Mr. Seeley has represented in his herd the best blood known in Shorthorns; Choice Goods, Whithall, Marshall, Cicely and other great ones have sons or daughters owned by Seeley.

#### Herefords.

The Herefords were not in top shape for show, but were a credit and the interest shown by the breeders is a step in the right direction. More should be out each year.
