The name of this corporation shall be The Eagles Building Association of Alliance. The principal place of transacting its business shall be at Alliance, Box Butte County, Nebraska, where meetings of the incorporators, stockholders and directors shall be held and all business transacted. The authorized capital stock of this corporation shall be Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) divided into two thousand five hundred shares (2,500) of the par value of ten dollars (\$10.00) each; the amount of capital stock with which said corporation will begin business is Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00); at such time as the Board of Directors may by resolution direct, said capital stock shall be paid into this corporation either in cash or by the sale and transfer to it of real or personal property, contracts, services, or any other valuable right or thing for the use and purposes of said corporation, in payment for which shares of the capital stock of said corporation may be issued and the capital stock so issued shall thereupon and thereby become and be fully paid up the same as though paid for in cash at par, and shall be non-assessable forever, and the judgment of the directors as to the value of any property, right or thing acquired in exchange for capital stock shall be conclusive.
