Republican County Convention.

Pursuant to the call of the Republican State Convention called to meet at Lincoln, Nebraska, on July 30th, 1912, for the purpose of adopting a platform and selecting a state central committee, the republican county convention for Lincoln county is hereby called to meet at North Platte, on July 25th, 1912, at 2 p. m., for the purpose of electing ten delegates to attend said state convention and for the selecting of a county central committee and for such other business as may come before the convention.

The basis of representation from the several precincts is based on the vote cast for Francis G. Hamer for judge of the supreme court in 1911, general election allowing one delegate for every 20 votes or major fraction thereof is as follows:

It is recommended that the precinct caucuses be held in the several precincts on Saturday, July 20th, 1912, and that at said meeting precinct committeemen be chosen for the ensuing year, at the same meeting that delegates are chosen to attend the county convention. All delegates should be furnished with proper credentials certified to by the Chairman and Secretary of the meeting at which they are chosen.

The Pity of It.
