Pruning Tomatoes.
Men and women who grow a few fine tomatoes in their own gardens for their own use have long practiced more or less pruning of the vines. Pruning is also practiced systematically when tomatoes are grown in hot-houses. As a rule, the field culture of tomatoes is not sufficiently remunerative to make pruning profitable. Professor Mendenhall found that pruning the plants after a part of the fruit had set increased the yield more than one-third. This was under conditions of field culture. It is possible that where the market is good an increase of one-third in the crop would pay for the work of pruning.—Country Gentleman.


