

WE HAVE A GOLD STANDARD.

THE UNITED STATES KICKS OVERBOARD THE ADVICE OF ITS FOUNDERS AND ADOPTS THE ENGLISH POLICY.

THE VEIL IS REMOVED—DEMOCRATS AND REPUBLICANS JOIN HANDS TO REPEAL.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Oct. 30.—
The three months' campaign for unconditional silver repeal is practically ended. A few minutes after 7 o'clock this evening the Senate passed the Voorhees bill by a vote of 43 to 32, as follows:

PAIRS—Allison with Mitchell of Ore., Chandler with White of Cal., Wilson with Hansborough; Gordon with Morgan. The Senators named first were for repeal.

Analysis of pairs—For repeal, republicans, 3; democrats, 2. Against repeal, republicans, 2; democrats, 3.

Analysis of vote—Yeas. Republicans, (SMALL CAPS) 23; Democrats (roman) 20. Nays—Republicans, 7; Democrats, 19; Populists [in CAPS] 6.

Total Republican strength for repeal, 26; total Democratic strength for repeal, 22; total Republican strength against repeal, 9; total Democratic strength against repeal, 22; total Populist strength against repeal, 6.

The Senate is composed of 44 Democrats, 35 Republicans, and 6 Populists.

The bill was sent to the House and passed on Wednesday, Nov. 1, by a vote of 181 to 94.
