SUGAR BEETS.

A number of Washington farmers have been experimenting with this industry, and have sent their beets to Washington, D. C., for analysis.

The result is shown in the following table:

	Average weight ounces.	Per Ct. of Sugar.
Medical Lake Dist.	9½	15.37
Chehalis	13	21.68
Oakesdale	19½	13.25
