

CONVENTION NOTES.

Ring Day at Republican Convention—One Ring Down the other—Sad day for The Old Ring—Although they had the Soda, the leaven would not rise—With the Power and the Helm, they COULD NOT STEER THEIR BOAT CLEAR OF THE TREACHEROUS MIRE AND SHARP FROST WHERE IT LIES BESIDE THEIR GRAVES.

Republican primaries held on Monday and the county convention held on Thursday of same week, when the country people were busy with their work and could not take the time to attend conventions.

As a result, a majority of the country delegations represented by proxies except Colockem, N. Kittitas and Tunnel, not represented at all. The town people can turn out one day as well as another.

Just note the final outcome, Tunnel, Easton, Mountain, Swauk, Culver, Peshastin, Mission, Colockem, E. Kittitas, N. Kittitas, and South Ellensburg precincts, which cast as the last general election in 1892, an aggregate vote of about 850, with no representation on either the delegation to the State convention or the county ticket. Roslyn cast 311 votes, gets one delegate to the State convention. South Kittitas cast 88 votes, one delegate to State convention.

CleElum 127 votes, gets one delegate to State convention.

Manastash 70 votes, gets one delegate to State convention.

West Kittitas 112 votes, gets assessor and one delegate to the State convention.

Wenatchee cast 219 votes, and gets one candidate for representative and three delegates to the State convention.

Liberty cast 54 votes, and gets the surveyor.

Ellensburg cast 450 votes, and gets one candidate for representative, auditor, sheriff, treasurer, clerk, county attorney, school supt. Coroner and four delegates to the State convention.

It is plainly to be seen there was a design in holding the convention at the time it was held.

The gentleman from New York taught the people a new way of electing temporary chairman of a convention on the 13th.

It is said J. L. Brown killed his candidate for sheriff in his nominating speech.
