**SCHOOL BOOKS.**

Now that our public schools are again in session and all working harmoniously, there need be no excuse for any children of school age to remain at home, but nevertheless, one occasionally finds children playing in the street, who, when the question if they attend school, will reply that they do not; that their parents are too poor to buy books. Such an excuse as this is not acceptable from either parent or child, for according to a previous ruling of the school board, which is on record, the indigent parents will have books supplied their children for use during the school term by making the proper application to the teacher, who is supposed to be provided with the necessary blank certificates and who will gladly fill out one of these, stating what books the child needs.

All that is then necessary is for the child or parents to present this certificate to the secretary of the school board and get the books that the certificates mention.

Parents owe it as a duty to their children to aid them in securing at least what is generally spoken of as a common school education, and those who feel that they are utterly unable to buy the necessary books for their children ought to go at once to the teacher and frankly state the exact condition of affairs. They ought not to put off this matter through a sense so called pride, for it isn't pride; its downright carelessness.—Tribune, Spokane.
