

MILLION DOLLAR STOCK PARADE TO CLAIM INTERSTATE FAIR EYES



Blooded Beauties of Territory to Parade Friday, September 24.

Reports now in the hands of Secretary Morton indicate that the Interstate Live Stock Fair at Sioux City will have difficulty in providing stall room and pens for the blooded horses, cattle and hogs that will compete for prize money during the period of the fair, September 20 to 25, inclusive.

Because this particular fair is staged in the heart of the greatest agricultural region in the United States, if not in the world, competition for prize awards have always been keener here than at the state fairs even and the cream of the herds and droves reached the competition barns yearly. This year the competition will take an even keener trend because of the increased awards in all departments.

On Friday of fair week the winners in all the horse and cattle classes will make the annual parade. The value of the animals has been estimated at over \$1,000,000 in former parades. Many blooded animals that have not

been seen at earlier fairs and exhibitions will be in the parade, because of the proximity of the breeding farms and the fact that owners will be running no danger of hoof and mouth disease.

The fair will continue its offer of \$1,000 in prizes for winners in the fat cattle division, an offer that holds on carload shipments. Winning cattle will be sold after the prize awards and will claim the usual high prices for the year.

The fair will also maintain its sheep sales. Competition in that stock department will be keen this year and much space has already been claimed by the herders. It is estimated that over half the hogs shown on the grounds last year were sold. The sales feature of the Sioux City fair is one big reason why the farmers have continued to show and to patronize the fair as a great clearing institution for well bred horses, cattle and hogs.
