Cure For Wrinkles. Wrinkles are caused by the diminution of the fatty particles which line the skin, and so the cuticle falls into lines, mostly appearing under the eyes and round the mouth.

Reliable Recipes. Fruit Cookies. One cup of butter, one and one-half cups sugar, three eggs, one-half cup molasses, one cup chopped raisins, one cup currants, one-half teaspoonful cloves, one teaspoonful cinnamon, spice to taste, one teaspoonful soda. Lard may be substituted for butter with little change in results.

To Test Eggs. Take a flat bottomed dishpan, put at least four inches of water in it and drop the egg in the water. If fresh it will lie perfectly level; if it rises at the thick end in the least it is not fresh.

To Clear Soup. There is only one secret about getting broth or soup clear without letting it get cold first and settle. No matter what ingredients you put into your soup or bouillon it will get muddy, but just put in a small onion or a piece of a large one and your broth will clear like magic.

LITTLE RHODE ISLAND SETS GOOD EXAMPLE

Through the Influence of Trades Unionism Child Labor is Steadily decreasing.

System of Factory Inspection Prevails That Aims at Eradicating the Evil.

Describing the decrease of child labor in Rhode Island, the Labor Bulletin of Massachusetts says: "The chief factory inspector of Rhode Island in his annual report said that in 1894, when the inspection bureau was created, the percentage of child labor was as high as 8.5, while last year it was but 4.5, little more than one-half."

The figures compared with those given in the last report show an increase of 5,932 in the number of male adults employed, an increase of 2,255 in the number of female adults employed, a decrease of 516 in the number of boys employed, a decrease of 266 in the number of girls employed, a total increase of 7,947 in the number of adults employed, a total decrease of 782 in the number of children employed, and a net increase of 7,165 in the whole number employed. The percentage of child labor was 7.9, and in 1894 it was 8.5.

"In the textile establishments engaged in the manufacture or finishing of cotton and woolen cloths and yarns, silk goods, threads, tapes, braids and twines the figures compared with those in last year's report show an increase of 1,680 in the number of adults employed, a decrease of 548 in the number of children employed and a net increase of 1,132 in the whole number employed in the textile industries. The percentage of child labor in these industries was 6.7. In 1905 the percentage was 7.9, and in 1894 it was 8.5.

"One hundred and thirty-one accidents have been reported during the year, three of which were fatal, the remaining accidents, but 28 were serious. "The chief inspector made the following recommendations: Authority for factory inspectors to demand proof of age; educational requirement prohibiting permanent employment of children unable to read and write English; harmony between factory inspection department and school officials.

"A free employment bureau was established on Jan. 19 in the selectmen place of the town of Weylesset. Notices were sent out to business men and manufacturers asking what openings for employment they had. All persons out of work were requested to communicate with the selectmen. No charge is to be made for finding positions."

DEMOCRATIC COUNTY CONVENTION OFFICIAL CALL

A Democratic delegate convention for the county of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, will be held on Saturday, May 9, 1908, at the City Hall in the City of Duluth, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon of said day, for the purpose of selecting twenty-nine delegates to the Demo-

cratic State convention, to be held in the City of St. Paul, on Thursday, May 14, 1908, for the purpose of choosing delegates to the National Democratic convention to be held at Denver, July 7, 1908, to nominate candidates for President and vice president of the United States.

Also for the purpose of designating a resident of said county who shall be recommended to the state convention for election as a member of the state central committee, and transact such other business as may properly come before the said convention. The basis of representation to the county convention shall be one delegate for each sixty acres of land for fraction thereof cast for Governor John Johnson at the last general election, and one delegate-at-large for each precinct.

In accordance with the above apportionment the several precincts will be entitled to the following number of delegates: City of Duluth. FIRST WARD. First precinct, 2; Second precinct, 2; Third precinct, 4; Fourth precinct, 4; Fifth precinct, 2; Sixth precinct, 1.
