

SLOGAN OF ALASKA'S LABOR PARTY SAYS WORKER OWN SAVIOR

CHATANIKA, Alaska, May 20.—The new labor party which was recently launched in Alaska held a rousing meeting here last Wednesday under the auspices of the Western Federation of Miners, but not confined to that organization alone, and nominated a candidate for congress.

"For over half a century the laboring men of the United States of America have been looking to, and depending on, the two dominant political parties of this country for relief from the oppressive encroachments of combined capital. Labor has appealed to them for redress and trusted them, giving loyal support at the polls and receiving empty platform pledges in return.

"After years of patient waiting and hoping, betrayal, treachery and misrepresentation are our only reward. With the issue of tariff high, tariff low and tariff for revenue only, labor is now working under an economic system which is being exploited of the wealth it is being allowed to retain barely sufficient for its elementary necessities.

"The legislative, executive and judicial branches of our government are in the hands of that element whose only belief in, or use of, the power of government is to impoverish the masses and bring about a condition of master and slave.

"We assert that the working class and it alone can and must achieve its own emancipation; that concerted political action is the only means of attaining this end.

"The United States of America, with its ninety millions of inhabitants, is about the only modern civilized country in the world where labor is unrepresented in the legislative branches of their government.

"Therefore, we the laborers and wealth producers of the Tanana valley, Alaska, in convention assembled, realizing the futility of further dependence in those parties which have so often betrayed us, and do of necessity enter the political field ourselves, and we endeavor through political action to secure those blessings guaranteed to us by our constitution to manage our own political affairs independently.

"We demand the establishment of postoffices at convenient points throughout the territory for the convenience of the people, and an improvement in our mail facilities. That large accumulations of second class mail matter addressed during the winter season to interior Alaska, remains at Valdez and other ports until the opening of navigation, to be returned to Seattle and shipped to its destination by water, thus depriving our citizens of all periodicals, magazines and outside newspapers for the greater part of the season, we believe it to be the duty of the government under those conditions to provide on a larger scale for the transportation of mail during the winter season, by stage route.

"We demand that congress grant to the people of Alaska a territorial form of government such as has been granted to the people of other territories in the United States, wherein the people of Alaska may enjoy a degree of self-government.

"In commenting on the new labor party and its platform the editor of the Nome Industrial Worker, an organ of the Western Federation of Miners, we read: "The labor party, however, needs no apology from the Industrial Worker. The establishment of such a party has been forced upon the workers of Alaska by the exigencies

of the political and industrial situation in this country. Naturally enough, the most crying abuses and which were the most obvious—wages and the most general attention. These abuses the labor party condemns and demands their amendment, not losing sight of the fact that the greatest amendment of all can only be carried out when the worker obtains the full product of his toil.

"No one can deny the glaring abuses under which Alaskans labor. We are practically without representation in congress wherein our delegate is not allowed to vote. Land, rich in mineral and agricultural values, is being daily absorbed by outside corporations, and for the most part for speculative purposes under the aegis of the conditions of entry. Workers in the absence of effective laws are daily, monthly and yearly defrauded of their wages by unscrupulous employers, and no sufficient precautions are taken to protect life and limb in the hazardous occupations which the workers follow.

"It would be a great mistake, however, to think that the labor party will stop short at the remedy of these abuses which we have just recited. Not by a long way. These are simply milestones on the road toward industrial freedom, and education, organization and independence are our guiding stars to that end. And we welcome all fellow travelers thither laboring under the same conditions, the destiny of the working class, through trials and tribulations of all kinds, is ultimately assured. We know that the journey entails labor and sacrifices are hard to give, but the end is worth all the toil and all the personal sacrifice that the working class may be called upon to make in this struggle of the toilers for industrial and political freedom."
