A. F. OF L. WITHDRAWS ITS ENDORSEMENT OF JOURNEMEN TAILORS' UNION LABEL

WASHINGTON, May 7.—The label of the Journeymen Tailors' union is no longer recognized by the American trade union movement, and officers of this organization have been notified by the A. F. of L. executive council that it "cancels and withdraws the endorsement of the label of the Journeymen Tailors' Union of America."

President Gompers was directed to publish in the Weekly News Letter a copy of the several actions taken by the executive council of the conditions existing in the Tailors' union, also in circular to be sent to each national and international union, state and city central body connected with the A. F. of L. and also to each local union of the Journeymen Tailors' Union and the United Garment workers of America.

"President Gompers is directed to confer and to meet with the United Hebrew Trades of New York for the purpose of having that body cease its harboring and supporting seceding garment workers located in New York city, and upon failure of that body to comply with the laws of the American Federation of Labor, the declarations and the Philadelphia convention of the A. F. of L., all international unions having local in New York represented in the United Hebrew Trades be required to direct such local unions to withdraw from the United Hebrew Trades."
