PEACE VOICED BY CANADIANS AT CONVENTION

TORONTO, Can., Oct. 5.—Emphatic opposition to conscription, advocacy of a peace conference proposed by the American Federation of Labor and the appointment of a Canadian industrial relations committee...

Findlay MacLennan, minister of public works in Ontario, welcomed the delegates in behalf of his province. J. E. Williams was seated as delegate from the British congress...

Canada was strongly urged to manufacture her own munitions of war instead of allowing them to be manufactured by private firms...

"Besides raising wages of workers," read the report, "by eliminating the private concern, the Dominion can thereby furnish the mother country with munitions at cost."

Following a review of the possible problems after the war, the council made five recommendations to the convention for aiding in the solution of the difficulties:

"First—The nationalization of railways, mines and other public utilities. "Second—The building of an extensive system of highways.

"Third—The adoption of a policy for land settlement which will provide sufficient aid to guarantee a permanent settlement on the land of those adapted to, or adaptable for, farming...

"Fourth—Shortening of the work-day to provide opportunity for the employment of every unemployed person."

WOMEN TO HOLD EIGHT-HOUR DAY CONFERENCE

CHICAGO, Oct. 5.—The Women's Trade Union league of this city, in co-operation with the league of St. Louis, Kansas City, and Springfield, have signed and sent out a call for a national conference to be held in Chicago, Oct. 7 and 8.

The conference is called to discuss and plan ways and means of securing the eight-hour day for working women, both by organization and legislation.

Because the conference is so important to all women workers of these states, it is hoped that the delegates to all these central bodies will support the call for delegates and send two of their best women workers.

BALTIMORE FORCED TO RAISE PAY OF WORKERS

BALTIMORE, Oct. 5.—Confronted with the ever-increasing demand for labor and the willingness on the part of private corporations to pay higher wages, the city will increase the wages of all men earning \$2 a day to \$2.25, beginning January 1 of next year.

At the last weekly conference of department heads in the mayor's reception room, the municipal executive directed the heads of the various departments employing laborers to include in their estimate of appropriations for next year such an increase.

The city has been sorely hit by the demand for labor. In all of the departments where big public work has been under way, there have been delays because of the inability to get men.

FARMERS AND LABOR TO HOLD CONFERENCE

QUINCY, Ill., Oct. 5.—A call has been issued for the first conference of union labor and farmers' organizations ever held in Illinois. It will be signed by President John H. Walker and Secretary Victor Olander of the Illinois Federation of Labor, and President Austin B. Hill and Secretary John P. Doyle of the Farmers' Educational and Co-Operative Union.

Legislation in which the farmers and union labor have joint interest will be considered by the conference, which will be held in Quincy on Oct. 18. That will be the week of the annual meeting here of the Illinois Federation of Labor, and it is expected there will be at least 1,000 persons in the conference.
