COAL MINERS AND RAIL MEN SEEK OPERATORS MUST FACE U. S. TRIAL IN PAY INCREASE

Federal Court Sustains Five Counts Charging 125 Men Violated Lever Act.

INDIANAPOLIS, May 26.—United States District Judge A. B. Anderson in federal court late today overruled the demurrer filed by Charles Evans Hughes, to the finding of the court this morning, which sustained five of the counts in the indictment charging 125 coal miners and operators with conspiracy to violate the Lever act.

RAIL MEN SEEK BILLION DOLLARS IN PAY INCREASE

Roads Favor "Fair Boost," but Object to "Unjust Demand," Says Whittier.

CHICAGO, May 26.—Fair wage increases for the 2,000,000 railroad employees in America are not opposed by the railroads, the labor board was informed by E. T. Whittier today in closing his reply to the demands of the men for increases in pay, which he said will total \$1,000,000,000 if granted.

Some Demands Opposed. The roads are opposed, however, to some of the demands presented to the labor board by the employees because they are "unjustified" and not upheld by the facts in the case, he said.
