COAL MINERS AND OPERATORS MUST FACE U. S. TRIAL

Federal Court Sustains Five Counts Charging 125 Men Violated Lever Act.

INDIANAPOLIS, May 28.—United States District Judge A. B. Anderson in federal court late today overruled the demurrer filed by Charles Evans Hughes, to the finding of the court this morning, which sustained five of the counts in the indictment charging 125 coal miners and operators with conspiracy to violate the Lever act. "Plea of not guilty was entered by the attorneys for the defendants with five exceptions, and Nov. 3 was the date set for the trial. Defendants in Illinois, Ohio and Missouri have brought proceedings to resist being brought into court here, only defendants residing in Pennsylvania and Indiana were in court today.

Special Pleas Entered.

Special pleas previously had been entered by Carl J. Fletcher of Indianapolis, secretary of the Knox County Coal Operators' association; M. L. Gould, Indianapolis, president of the Linton Coal company; Jonas Waffle, of Terre Haute, secretary of the Indiana Coal Trade bureau, and H. W. Little of Terre Haute, secretary of the Southern Indiana Coal bureau.

The indictment against the bituminous miners and operators was an outgrowth of the recent bituminous strike and originally collected 18 counts, based on the Lever act and the criminal code.

Judge Anderson, today, however, acting on a motion made by Mr. Hughes, chief counsel for the United Mine Workers of America, in the case against 12 of the counts in the indictment, and at the same time declared unconstitutional three sections of the Lever act, Sections 4, 5, and amended section 4, on which the counts of the indictment were based.

Five counts in the indictment based on section 5 of the Lever act, the court held to be operative and because of the constitutional question, Hughes' motion to quash the indictment was overruled.

A demurrer was filed by Mr. Hughes to the court's ruling sustaining the five counts and arguments were heard on it immediately after the overruling followed late this afternoon.

Judge Anderson's ruling on the demurrer followed late this afternoon.
