Articles of Incorporation OF AUDITORIUM GARAGE COMPANY.

Know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned, desiring to form a corporation for the purpose herein expressed, have severally signed and acknowledged these articles of incorporation, and that we do hereby associate ourselves together and agree to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Minnesota.

ARTICLE FIRST.
