

followed by 11 others, and this defection not leaving a working majority in session, the meeting adjourned. Amongst those leaving was a Representative of the "People's Organ" and two of Gov. Wickliffe's appointees, who began to find things unbecomingly warm. When a man has a good fat office, and has a presentiment that it will expire by limitation in about six months, he becomes very much disgusted with political abstractions. When a game has been played and lost, the loser becomes very variable in his temper and like a drowning man will catch at a crow-bar as quick as a life preserver, if it is thrown at him. So it is with those officeholders. I advised them not to pitch in. I conjured them to let "well enough alone" but they heeded it not—their voting the State ticket now, after failing to organize an opposition, won't do—who cares a fig how they vote or whether they vote or not? Why, none. They might as well follow their leader, the Hon. P. Soule, and vote the Know Nothing ticket; there is nothing else left for them to do. The Sillid miscreants will give them no place in the distribution of the offices. There are plenty left, who are willing to serve the country at any expense. One of the bolters from the Southern Douglas Club said, that he had opposed Mr. Sillid, because he represented the "One Man Power," but that he had found some the embodiment of that same power, and that he had concluded, as he could not expect that Sillid, he would for the future, run with a 40 horse power in preference to a one horse. He says he is willing to ride in a third class car, rather than be left behind. His case will be left with the conductor. He has been suddenly converted to Sillidism. That independent journal, "The People's Organ," has permitted itself to be mislead. It no longer grinds the Opposition tune—for if that paper advocates Opposition, it jeopardizes the re-election of the pure and immaculate Miles; and devotion to men instead of principles has been the characteristic of the True Delta since I have been an observer of its course. The manner of Mr. Taylor's nomination was notoriously unfair, yet the Sillid men submitted for the sake of Democracy, without a murmur. It is their intention to support Mr. Taylor and to give him an honest and hearty support; but the True Delta is anxious to run a ticket in opposition to the State ticket, let him advocate it boldly and he will find that there are plenty of Democrats who believe in "fighting the devil with fire" and are ready for the conflict. The election of the State ticket is a fixed fact and the editors of the True Delta are aware of it—they can't prevent it—and of the three Congressional nominations already made there is not a doubt of the election of Landrum and Davidson—neither will have opposition—but the re-election of Mr. Taylor is not quite so certain. His friends may defeat him, his opponents cannot. LITTLE R.

district in '57 by a majority of 1887, opposed him. Both are men of talent, but Mr. Brown's regular nomination probably elected him.

6. In the sixth district Elliott Dem. who was elected in '57 by a majority of 1520, declined a re-nomination. He has served in Congress long and well. Theophilus T. Garrard was the Democratic nominee and Green Adams opposition candidate. The latter was in Congress in '47 and '49, being then a Wilmot profligate. Garrard was of course elected.

7. In the seventh Louisville district, Thomas H. Ho, who was defeated by Rum Key Marshall, or rather by the hired bullies of Louisville, in 1857 by a majority of 1106, was the Democratic candidate again, under more favorable auspices. Robt. Mallory K. N. opposed him and was probably elected.

8. In the eighth (Ashland) district James B. Clay declined a re-election. Capt. Wm. E. Simms Dem. was opposed by John M. Harlan K. N. a son of the opposition candidate for Attorney General. The struggle of the federalists to recover this district is hard, and they have been nursing young Harlan for years for this purpose. As Clay's majority was only 126, and as the K. N. majority in the district in 1855 when A. K. Marshall was elected was over fifteen hundred, we are prepared to hear that the vote was close.

9. Judge J. W. Moore Dem. against Laban T. Moore opposition. The candidates are brothers. The district is Democratic by a majority of 600 or more.

10. In the tenth John W. Stevenson, who was elected in '57 by a majority of 4563 was renominated by the Democrats and had no opposition. The last delegation from Kentucky was 2 Dem. 2 K. N. The delegation now elected is probably about the same. We may have gained the third, but there is a possibility that we have lost the fourth.

Our opponents here will be influenced in their movements by the result of the election in Kentucky. If the Democratic State ticket there shall prove to have failed, (if such a thing is imaginable) the opposition in Louisiana will nominate State candidates without delay.
