THE STATE OF LOUISIANA AND PARISH OF RAPIDES VS. DELINQUENT TAX DEBTORS, PARISH OF RAPIDES.

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana, I will sell at the principal front door of the Court House of the Parish of Rapides, in which the civil District Court of said Parish is held, within the legal hours for judicial sales, beginning at 11 o'clock A. M., on Saturday, the 16th of December, A. D. 1882,

and continuing on Monday and each succeeding day until said sales are completed, all immovable property on which taxes are now due to the State of Louisiana and Parish of Rapides, to enforce collection of all taxes assessed in the years 1880 and 1881, together with interest thereon respectively from the 31st day of December, 1880, and from the 31st day of December, 1881, at the rate of eight per cent. per annum and all costs. 
