THE ELECTIONS OF 1883.

The elections this year are not highly important, but they cover three or four States whose influence on the Presidential election will be considerable.

Maryland will elect a Democratic Legislature and Democratic Governor. The majority of Gov. Hamilton in 1870 was 43,917.

Iowa will elect a Republican Legislature, Governor, etc. Gov. Sherman's plurality in 1881 was 59,920 in a total vote of 235,037.

Minnesota will elect a Republican Governor, etc. Gov. Hubbard's majority in 1881 was 27,830.

Mississippi will elect a Democratic Legislature.

Rhode Island has elected a Republican Legislature, Governor, etc.

The elections consequential because indicative of popular currents are the following:

New York will elect a Legislature and minor State officials. The result will show whether those liberal Republicans and anti monopolists who came to the Democrats in 1882 are going to stay.

Massachusetts will elect Legislature, Governor, etc. The vote will determine the consequences of General Butler's bold course—whether it has strengthened the Democrats or otherwise.

Ohio will elect Legislature, Governor, etc. The vote will determine how far the liquor question has demoralized the Republican party.

Connecticut elects a House and half the Senate. It will serve to show the trend of popular feeling.

New Jersey will elect a Governor, Representatives and one-third the Senate. The vote for Governor in 1880 (the term is three years) was 121,668 for Ludlow, Democrat; 121,015 for Potts, Republican; 27,599 for Hoxsey, Greenback, and 195 for Ransom, Prohibitionist.

Pennsylvania will elect a State Treasurer, and the vote will be awaited with interest to see whether the independent Republicans will go back to the machine.

Virginia will elect a Legislature, and the Democrats hope to recapture the State. The present Legislature has on joint ballot 81 Republicans and 59 Democrats.

The nominations in Kentucky are already made. The election occurs August 5. In Ohio the conventions begin this week, and the election is October 9.

Iowa elects the same day this year, but in 1884 her State election occurs on November 4. Rhode Island's election occurred on April 3.

The resolutions of the Democratic State Conventions will possess interest as pointers.
