REGISTERED LETTERS.-Under the new system, which went into effect June 1st, registered letters are a very safe means of sending small sums of money where post-office money orders cannot easily be obtained.

The registry fee, as well as postage, must be paid in stamps at the office where the letter is mailed, or it will be liable to be sent to the dead letter office. Buy and affix the stamps, both for the postage and registry, put in the money and seal the letter in the presence of the postmaster.
