George Forbes vs. Thomas J. Franklin, J. Harris Franklin, Benj. G. Harris, Bernard L. Hayden, Francis Neale, Benj. G. Harris, Baltimore, Wm. A. Padgett.

In the Circuit Court for St. Mary's County, sitting in Equity. NO. 105 N. E.

THE object of the bill, filed in this case, is to procure a decree to perfect title to a certain tract of land, lying in Saint Mary's County, called and known as "CENTRA."

The bill, substantially, states that the said tract of land, heretofore, was owned by the said George Forbes—that said Forbes, on or about the year aforesaid, gave the said tract of land, by way of advancement, to his daughter, Josephine Franklin, then the wife of Thomas J. Franklin—that said Josephine Franklin and her husband, Thomas J. Franklin, soon afterwards sold said tract of land to a certain Benjamin G. Harris for the sum of four thousand and one hundred dollars, but said Harris never paid the purchase money for same. That said Harris subsequently sold the said tract of land to a certain Bernard L. Hayden and said Hayden sold same to a certain Joseph H. Maddox and that said Maddox engaged the name of George Forbes, the complainant in this bill. That said Forbes foreclosed said mortgage by proceeding in the Circuit Court for Saint Mary's County, in Equity, and at trustee's sale purchased said tract of land. That after said purchase and before the said Forbes was informed, that the purchase money was unpaid, and obtained as lien by aforesaid Franklin. Also that certain other liens were claimed on said land by a certain Francis Neale and Benjamin G. Harris of Baltimore and a certain Wm. A. Padgett.

That while the said George Forbes, the complainant, does not admit any of said pretended liens, he is unable to perfect his title to said tract of land or to dispose of same. And he therefore prays the intervention of this Court of Equity to protect his interest and establish and perfect his title to said land.

The supplemental bill filed in this case further states, that Bernard L. Hayden, one of the defendants in this case, since filing original bill and return of subpoena, has departed the State and is now beyond the jurisdiction of this Court. And prays that an order of publication may be granted against him warning him to appear in this Court, either in person or by solicitor, on some certain day, to be named therein, to answer bill of complaint of said complainant.

By virtue of authority vested in me as Clerk of the Circuit Court for Saint Mary's County, it is therefore ordered, that the 15th day of June, in the year 1868, that the complainant in this cause give notice to the aforesaid non-resident defendant, of the object and substance of this bill by advertisement of this order in the Saint Mary's Beacon, once a week for four successive weeks, three months prior to the 10th day of October next, warning him to appear in this Court, either in person or by solicitor, on the day aforesaid, to answer the same, if any he has, why a decree should not be passed in the premises as prayed, otherwise the said bill shall be taken pro confesso, against him.
