Congress is still in session, but the Lower House passed a resolution to adjourn on the 15th (tomorrow). Joint Resolutions have been adopted removing the tariff on salt, coal, tea and coffee.

FOUND DEAD.—On the 2nd instant, a Black man was found dead near the mouth of Calvert's Creek in St. Inigo's district. Dr. Justice Tenneson held an inquest on the body, and the conclusion was reached, that the deceased came to his death from a blow on the head by a heavy round iron. There was nothing found on the person of the man that could enable the jury to discover either his name or any particular of his history. In fight, the man was 5 feet, 8 inches, stout, about 22 years of age, had on two shirts and no other clothing, and had, probably, been dead two or three days when found.

It is too evident, we fear, that this man was murdered and that the murderer strip the body with a view of preventing an identification of the remains. The murderer was a stranger to the district, and it is something more than likely that he was employed at the time of his death on board one of the numerous vessels that are now constantly engaged in catching oysters in the waters adjacent to Point Lookout. The frequency of similar outrages in this section, and, indeed, upon other oyster grounds of our State, should induce some legislation next Winter, or some action by the proper authorities, looking to the better protection of the lives of laborers engaged in this State in the oyster trade or at least to the discovery of some means to prevent now exist to find out and punish the bold and reckless thief who has defied in our waters for years and is now defying the laws both of God and man. Our own civil authorities, though doing the best they can, are powerless to prevent or to punish these outrages. The crime is perpetrated on the water and some distance from the shore. Every trace that might lead to the identification of the murdered man is completely destroyed. The body is pitched overboard in a day or so floats ashore and is decomposed. The service of a Coroner is not intended and a jury is summoned. The verdict is, that the man was murdered, that he is unknown to the jury, that he is so many feet and inches high, that he probably so many years old, and that he died of the murder. This is the very thing our civil officers can do under the circumstances, and the best is practically nothing towards the discovery and punishment of the murderer.
