Colton and Bond to the House; J. Frank Ford Clerk of the Circuit Court; J. T. H. Raley Register of Wills; Capt. Benj. Foxwell Sheriff; John Parsons, John H. Abell, Philip H. Dorsey, A. C. Tennyson and A. P. Fenwick County Commissioners, and George B. Dent Surgeon. ELECTIONS IN MARYLAND AND ELSEWHERE.—The democrats, from the partial returns given in the Baltimore papers, have undoubtedly carried the State by an unusually heavy majority on the popular vote, Baltimore city alone giving over fourteen thousand majority on the State ticket. The new Legislature will be nearly, if not quite, as one-sided as the last. In the counties, so far as heard from, the democrats have also generally succeeded in their local struggles. In New York and Virginia the same party has swept every thing before it, the popular majorities ranging from 25 to 30 thousand in each. Indeed, the returns from every State and almost every locality where an election was held on the 4th, show that the democrats have either triumphed outright or have so limited their vote as to place themselves within easy striking distance of victory hereafter. The future of parties it is now impossible to forecast, but it is very certain that a grave mistake was made when the democratic party was announced to be "dead" beyond all hope of resurrection.
