**School Report.**  
Our thanks are due Prof. M. A. Newell for a copy of the Sixteenth Annual Report of the State Board of Education. The report shows, that in this county, the white have 41 and the colored 19 school houses; the number of different pupils for the year 1882, was white, 1553, colored, 1087; average attendance of pupils, white 640, colored 291. The Leonardtown School had during the year 103 different pupils—the largest attendance of any white school in the county. W. B. Dent, of the 7th district, came next with 82. Joo. Gajay, Teacher of Dorton school, No. 2, 1st Election district, had during the year 139 different pupils, the largest attendance of any. F. A. Moran, came next, with 94. In the county there were 21 teachers. Of these 49 were white and 18 colored.

**Commissioners' Court.**  
Board met at the Almshouse on Tuesday, the 22nd instant, present all the members. They inspected the buildings and farm and found the former in a neat and orderly condition and the latter in a fair state of cultivation. They then adjourned to the office, where the following business was transacted:—State and County bonds, with sureties, of G. Hayden Russell, Collector of 7th district, and W. L. Hammett, with sureties, Collector of 8th district, approved. Re-ignation of G. F. Davis, Constable 4th district, accepted, and Wm. A. Lyon, Jr., appointed in his place. Re-ignation of J. P. Gough, Collector of 2nd district, accepted, and J. Lewis is Milburn appointed in his place. County bonds of P. F. Smith approved. The following accounts for road work were passed:—John W. Carter, \$3.25. Henry Cartery, \$11.00. A. Burroughs, \$5.50. Wm. A. Lyon, 50 cents, and James H. Burch, 50 cents. The Court adjourned to the 1st Tuesday in June.

Morgan, admr. of Jos. Travers, filed. The Court then adjourned to Tuesday, June 5th.

**St. Ingoes Items.**  
Strawberries are getting ripe. Now, is it not remarkably strange that some persons' taste is so vitiated that the delicious berries are not palatable? It is said—no doubt true for its accuracy—that laces and silk are preferred by certain old bachelors of Lovington to the succulent fruit aforesaid. A disease similar to the epizootic is killing dogs and cats at several St. Thomases has succumbed to the disease. By-the-way, quite a touching incident occurred not many days ago near our village. A dog that has been keeping the rabbits from destroying perennial flowers growing upon the grave of three dear little children who died of the diphtheria last July, died of the distemper above named. Before the animal died, it passed by the graves, screaming for the purpose of taking a farewell look, and then went several yards and died facing the spot it had so carefully guarded. The faithful animal, Trip, lies embosomed near its little master's grave, and beautiful butterflies wing their way alternately sipping the "sweets" of delicate flowers that grow upon the last resting place of master and dog.

**The Smokers.**  
The Scientific American speaking of the value of the smoker, says:  
"Agriculturists claim it is the best egg-raiser during the winter months, keeping them in a thriving condition and largely increasing the production of eggs. Every poultry raiser should have in his stable this best food known for glooming the plumage of fowls, and who is not indispensable to those who want to fit their birds for exhibition to the best advantage. The Russian smokeworm is easily raised, requires very little care, can be grown in fence corners, or other places difficult to cultivate. Its production of seed is immense, yielding often at the rate of one hundred bushes to the acre. It should be planted in hills four feet apart, any time from now to the first of July. Three quarts of seed will plant an acre."
