

# Saint Mary's Beacon.

**WORTH KNOWING.**—Buttermilk will take out mildew stains. Bottles are easily cleaned with hot water and fine coals. Old napkins and old tablecloths make the very best glass cloths. Ammonia will often restore colors that have been removed by acid. Zinc is best cleaned with hot soapy water, then polished with kerosene. Oil cloth can be kept bright for years if properly varnished each year.

If the hands are rubbed on a stick of celery after peeling onions the smell will be entirely removed. If soap is purchased in large quantities, and kept in a warm, dry place, half the usual amount will be required. Tubs, etc., will not warp or crack if the precaution be taken to put a pail of water into each directly after use.

Fresh meat, when frying, should not be salted until it is nearly cooked, for salting makes the juices of the meat run out, and the meat is not so tender. Marks that have been made on paint with matches can be removed by rubbing first with a slice of lemon, then with whiting and washing with soap and water. Brooms put into boiling water once a week will become tough and durable, lasting twice as long as those not treated thus, will sweep better, and will not cut the carpet.

**HOW THINGS GROW IN HAWAII.**—How great are the possibilities of Hawaii as a fruit and vegetable growing country will be understood when it becomes known that four crops of potatoes have been produced in succession on the same piece of land within twelve months. Radishes become edible ten days after sowing. Strawberry vines bear fruit all the year. The berries are of the finest flavor. Cabbage grows all the year and it apparently makes no difference whether it is planted in the spring, summer, autumn or winter. Parsley once sown grows forever, apparently. Lima beans continue to grow and bear for over a year, and they have to be gathered every week after starting to bear. Cucumbers bear the entire year, and so do tomatoes, which, with proper attention, grow for years. Raspberries bear for six months.

"Pineapples come into bearing when the plants are four months old and bear in abundance for years. Lettuce can be planted at any time and it develops quickly. The same is true of celery.
