Democratic Platform.

The platform, as adopted by the St. Louis convention, is as follows: The Democratic party of the United States, in national convention assembled, declares its devotion to the essential principles of the Democratic faith which bring us together in party communion.

Fundamental Principles. The application of these fundamental principles to the living issues of the day is the first step toward the assured peace, safety and progress of our nation.

Capital and Labor. We favor the enactment and administration of laws giving labor and capital impartially their just rights.

Constitutional Guarantees. Constitutional guarantees are violated whenever any citizen is denied the right to labor, acquire and enjoy property or reside where he chooses.

Economy of Administration. Large reductions can easily be made in the annual expenditures of the Government without impairing the efficiency of any branch of the public service.

Contracts With Trusts. We condemn the action of the Republican party in Congress in refusing to prohibit an executive department from entering into contracts with convicted trusts or unlawful combinations in restraint of interstate trade.

Executive Usurpation. We favor the nomination and election of a President imbued with the principles of the Constitution, who will set his face sternly against executive usurpation of legislative and judicial functions.

Imperialism. We favor the preservation, so far as we can, of an open door for the world's commerce in the Orient, without an unnecessary entanglement in the Oriental and European affairs.

Philippines And Cubans. We insist that we ought to do for the Philippines what we have done already for the Cubans, and it is our duty to make that promise now and upon suitable guarantees of protection to citizens of our own and other countries resident at the time of our withdrawal.

Tariff Legislation. The Democratic party has been, and will continue to be, the consistent opponent of that class of tariff legislation which is not based upon the protection of industry.

Unlawful Combinations. We recognize that the gigantic trusts and combinations designed to enable capital to secure more than its just share of the joint products of capital and labor.

Interstate Commerce. We demand an enlargement of the powers of the Interstate Commerce Commission to the end that the traveling public and shippers of this country may have prompt and adequate relief from the abuses to which they are subjected in the matter of transportation.

Reclamation of Arid Lands. We congratulate our Western citizens upon the passing of the law known as the Newland Irrigation act for the reclamation and reclamation of the arid lands of the West.
