

PROCLAMATION

Publication of Proposed Constitutional Amendments.

Whereas, At the January Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, held in the year of our Lord, Nineteen Hundred and Ten, three Acts were passed, one proposing an Amendment to Article 1 of the Constitution, by adding thereto a Section to be known as Section 8; one proposing an Amendment to Section 2 of Article 3 of said Constitution, and one proposing an Amendment to Section 4 of Article 3 of said Constitution, said Acts being respectively Chapter 205, 206 and 207 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1910, and which are in the words following, to wit:

CHAPTER 205.
 An Act to propose an Amendment to Article 1 of the Constitution of this State by adding thereto a new Section, to be known as Section 8, to follow Section 7 and to provide for the submission of said Amendment to the qualified voters of this State for adoption or rejection.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, three-fifths of all members of each of the two Houses concurring, that the following section be and the same is hereby proposed as an Amendment to Article 1 of the Constitution of this State, which said section, if adopted by the qualified voters of this State, shall stand as an additional section to said Article 1, to be known as Section 8, to follow Section 7, of said Article.

CHAPTER 206.
 An Act to amend Section 4 of Article 3 of the Constitution of this State, and to provide for the submission of said Amendment to the qualified voters of this State for adoption or rejection.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, three-fifths of all members of each of the two Houses concurring, that the following section be and the same is hereby proposed as an Amendment to Section 4 of Article 3 of the Constitution of this State, and to provide for the submission of said Amendment to the qualified voters of this State for adoption or rejection.

CHAPTER 207.
 An Act to amend Section 4 of Article 3 of the Constitution of this State, and to provide for the submission of said Amendment to the qualified voters of this State for adoption or rejection.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, three-fifths of all members of each of the two Houses concurring, that the following section be and the same is hereby proposed as an Amendment to Section 4 of Article 3 of the Constitution of this State, and to provide for the submission of said Amendment to the qualified voters of this State for adoption or rejection.

Each of the several counties of the State having a population of eighteen thousand souls or less, shall be entitled to two Delegates; and every county having a population of over eighteen thousand and less than twenty-eight thousand shall be entitled to three Delegates; and every county having a population of twenty-eight thousand and less than forty thousand shall be entitled to four Delegates; and every county having a population of forty thousand and less than fifty thousand shall be entitled to five Delegates; and every county having a population of fifty thousand and less than sixty thousand shall be entitled to six Delegates; and every county having a population of sixty thousand and less than seventy thousand shall be entitled to seven Delegates; and every county having a population of seventy thousand and less than eighty thousand shall be entitled to eight Delegates; and every county having a population of eighty thousand and less than ninety thousand shall be entitled to nine Delegates; and every county having a population of ninety thousand and less than one hundred thousand shall be entitled to ten Delegates; and every county having a population of one hundred thousand and less than one hundred and twenty thousand shall be entitled to eleven Delegates; and every county having a population of one hundred and twenty thousand and less than one hundred and forty thousand shall be entitled to twelve Delegates; and every county having a population of one hundred and forty thousand and less than one hundred and sixty thousand shall be entitled to thirteen Delegates; and every county having a population of one hundred and sixty thousand and less than one hundred and eighty thousand shall be entitled to fourteen Delegates; and every county having a population of one hundred and eighty thousand and less than two hundred thousand shall be entitled to fifteen Delegates; and every county having a population of two hundred thousand and less than two hundred and twenty thousand shall be entitled to sixteen Delegates; and every county having a population of two hundred and twenty thousand and less than two hundred and forty thousand shall be entitled to seventeen Delegates;
