"That the County Commissioners shall make out and publish annually in at least two newspapers published in their respective counties, if there be two, a detailed statement and account of the expenditures of said county, specifying therein each particular item of expense and for what and to whom paid, and shall also deliver to the Sheriff of their respective counties as many copies of said statement as there are election districts of said county at least ten days before each general election, and the Sheriff shall within six days after the election of such copies, set up one of them at the place of holding elections in each district."
