The Free State men of Doniphan county, at their late nominating Convention, passed the following resolution, quite unlike those passed in this county: "Resolved, That the only issue between the people of Doniphan county is freedom or slavery, and that we recognize as good Free State men all who are in favor of making Kansas a Free State.

In Doniphan county, the party is laboring to gain accessions to it. In Douglas county, if the Convention of the 20th ult. was a Free State Convention, as some of the members claim, they were desirous of driving out all the members they could from the party.

The Pacific Railroad Company have just issued orders for the completion of their road west to Gilroy by the first of December. The grading is said to be heavy on a portion of the route, and on that account a large force has been employed to hurry the work forward.

Gilroy is situated at the point where the Warsaw and Boonville road crosses the Pacific Railroad, and is now the starting point of the California Overland Mail. We are not advised of the distance this will be west of Jefferson City, but would suppose it some fifty miles or more.

"The Dutch have taken Holland," and the Republicans have triumphed in this representative district. We have not the returns complete, so shall defer a tabular statement of the vote for the present. The vote in this county, on Monday last, was for Branscombe, 971; Morrow, 1,001; Townsend, 731; Curtis, 633; Woodward, 1,055; Cannon, 693; Lockhart, 694; Hovey, 1,001; Bruner, 336; Shores, 336; Berkus, 373; Martin, 313. Curtis has 293 majority in this county over Berkus; and Cannon has 357 over Shores.

The Territorial Central Committee have determined upon calling a Free State Delegate Convention, to be held in Lawrence on the second Wednesday of November. We see no necessity for such a Convention, but if it is to be held, the People would do well to be represented in it.
