 Ex-Police John Leary Dies at Holyoke, Mass.
 John Leary of Holyoke, Mass., formerly of this city, died early Tuesday morning at a hospital in Northampton, Mass., after an illness of several months. He was born in Cherryfield, Me., in 1850, and came from that place to Willimantic, where he resided for a number of years. Mr. Leary went to Holyoke 22 years ago and was employed by the Holyoke Machine company for five years. In May, 1892, he was appointed to the police force by Mayor J. F. Sullivan and remained on the force until last summer, when he was compelled to relinquish his duties because of illness.

He resigned from the force last October. Mr. Leary was very well known and liked as a man and an official, and was a competent and faithful officer on the Holyoke force.

There survive a widow and two sons, John and Edward, and five daughters, Mrs. James Walsh, Misses Gertrude, Margaret, Theresa and Agnes Leary, all of Holyoke. He leaves three sisters, Mrs. Henry Monahan, Mrs. Andrew Harrington and Miss Margaret Leary, all of Hartford.
