JOHN H. HOWE FOUND DEAD

Passenger on Trolley Saw Body Lying on Railroad Track East of Stonington—Cause of Death Uncertain—Session of Probate Court—Mrs. Sisson in Serious Condition from Auto Accident.

When the trolley car of the Groton-Stonington road, leaving Stonington for Westery, Tuesday morning, reached the trolley bridge over the tracks of the New York, New Haven & Hartford railroad, in the Westport section, Oscar Cook, one of the passengers, saw the body of a man, just east of the trolley bridge, lying between the rails of the east-bound track on the steam road.

It was at first supposed the dead man was Mr. White of Mystic, as a letter that protruded from an outside pocket bore that address, but Mystic people identified the body as that of John H. Howe of Mystic, who had been for years a weaver for the Mystic Manufacturing company.

It is believed that Mr. Howe was visiting Westery and that he started to walk home by the railroad track after the trolley cars had ceased running for the night.

The body was between the rails of the east-bound track and was not mangled, although the left hip was crushed, as was the lower part of the back, and there were internal injuries, as blood oozed from the nose and ears.

It is barely possible that Mr. Howe may have started for home after daylight, walking over the trolley route, and fallen through the dry bridge, and received fatal injuries in that way.
