Westerly Hears High Grade Music

Fourth Entertainment in Teachers' Course Provided by Smalley Trio—Another Move Towards Construction of Post Office Building—Vicinity Notes—Personals

While the bid of the trustees of the Hannal E. W. Brown estate of \$20,000 to furnish a site for the proposed new postoffice building has been accepted, actual purchase has not been made. The building project has progressed so far that the tenants of the second story of the present postoffice building are seeking or have secured quarters elsewhere. The site accepted is in part occupied by the present postoffice building, a two-story brick structure, and owned by the Brown estate.

According to the terms of the bid, this building must be removed from the premises thirty days after the bid is transferred, the government purchasing the land, but not the building. The Brown estate is to be sold, and includes among other properties, the plot from the Memorial building to the Mitchell-Hinckley building, High street, upon which are located the Brown homestead and the postoffice building, and the vacant side of the street is the Brown business block and the big vacant lot backing upon the river and the vacant lot between the Brown and Porter-Loveland buildings.

Capt. Walter E. Harrington, who, in connection with his duties as company commander, served as range officer at the state rifle range at Mumford, will probably remain in the military service of Rhode Island. After a court martial had found him guilty of certain charges, which resulted in a public reprimand, the captain tendered his resignation, and Col. Charles E. Tillman accepted it. Effort was made to have Captain Harrington withdraw his resignation, and it was therefore not accepted. Now the resignation has been returned to him and the incident is believed to be closed.

The directors of the Atlantic Shipping company have decided to build a big schooner to take the place of the Governor Ames, which was lost last December by striking on Wible shoals, off of Rhode Island. After all of the crew being drowned except one sailor, it is stated that the schooner will be built at Nat's Point shipyard, Stonington, and the work will begin early in May, and the designs are being prepared. The ship will be just west of the Stonington station and close to the railroad tracks. The schooner Panny Prescott and Florence Howard have been built there within the past three years, the latter being launched last

September. It is said that the new schooner will be even larger than the Prescott or Howard. Capt. Charles A. Davis of Somerset, Massachusetts, of the best known mariners along the Atlantic coast, is general manager of the Atlantic Shipping Co. He supervised the construction of the Prescott and the Howard and will be in charge of the building of the big schooner to replace the Governor Ames.
