E. M. Wheaton Gives Land to Town with This End in View.

E. M. Wheaton has given a piece of his land below the fair grounds near Brookfield to the town of Putnam for the purpose of straightening the highway.

Work has commenced which when finished will run north and south through the curves, made the grade easier and the condition of the road generally better.

The new layout of the road will bring it through Mr. Wheaton's property on a line nearly parallel with the old tracks. There are to be a considerable of a fill at this point, work on it having begun.

FRENCH RIVER TEXTILE CO.

Large Addition to Their Plant at Mechanicville to Be Begun Today.

Ground will be broken this morning for a large brick addition to the mill of the French River Textile company at Mechanicville. The contract has been let to a Providence firm and their representatives were in Putnam Tuesday looking for men and teams wanted in the work of making the excavation.

The French River company, manufacturing the grades of worsted, has been one of the most prosperous in Connecticut, and their mill has been for many years one of the largest in the state.

The new part will enable them to complete the new plant in the near future. The addition also means the employment of an increased number of operators and the grades of worsted for more trade among Putnam business men; for much of the buying by Mechanicville residents is done in this city.
