THE GREAT WHITE PLAGUE IN CONNECTICUT

Interesting Address by State Tuberculosis Commissioner Gustaber at a Workmen's Meeting Sunday Afternoon in New Haven.

New Haven, Jan. 22.—At a workmen's meeting held in this city, this morning, the State Tuberculosis Commissioner, Gustaber, delivered an interesting address on the "white plague," and in reply to Governor Baldwin's message that public spirited citizens could be found who would carry on the fight against the disease, without compensation he spoke in part as follows:

It was about four years ago that Governor Woodruff appointed a commission to investigate tuberculosis, which included among its number two noted authorities from your city, the late Dr. J. P. C. Foster and Dr. S. J. Maher—and after two years of careful study the commission reported its findings to the general assembly. The bill creating the present commission, which passed that body by a unanimous vote, and was signed by Governor Woodruff.

Found Sanatorium Closed. The question recently raised of having the work done by public spirited citizens, without compensation, was unanimously in their opinion that this would be impracticable, as it was found that one of the state's leading sanatoriums had closed its doors for lack of interest and another was having a hard struggle to make ends meet.

Great Work by Newspapers. The commission also found that the newspapers of the large cities educational in their character, and that the people contributed money, through organizations, to aid sufferers of the disease; that, also, in many parts of the state the people were doing a noble work in caring for sufferers who were one thing and filers was another. And, now, after a year and a half of hard work by the commission, which has convinced one member his life, the truth of this opinion held by the investigators has been fully established.

Prevention, Not Cure. It was the hope of the investigators that in time the sanatoriums in the various counties would not be needed, that the goal sought was prevention, not cure, and that the people, men and not theorists could such a conclusion be brought about; that such a monster problem as tuberculosis, which cost the lives of thousands, could be solved by people who have a had and seek notoriety for self honor.

New Cases in December. The health officers of the four largest cities report new cases for December as follows: Bridgeport 39, New Haven 30, Waterbury 17, and Hartford 8, which are as regular as clockwork.

doing effective work, combating the disease.

Care of Dependents. The most important feature of this whole problem is how to care for those who are dependent on a bread-winner, affected with this disease, while he is taking the treatment. We say we can cure incipient cases, if we get them in time, but in numerous cases this is impossible, because they refuse to stop work and have their dependents subjects of charity, which is a cold proposition at its best, and the state will have to deal with this question if we ever hope to obtain the best results.

It costs the state about \$6 a week for those in our state homes at present, and if they are beyond the incipient stage they will receive treatment from two to four years before the disease is arrested, and death claims then, whereas, if they were received as incipients, a cure would be effected in most cases in six months' time, and from an economic standpoint the state would save a vast amount of money and lives if provision were made whereby dependents would be cared for.

Employers Help Now. In most of our large cities, employers of labor are co-operating with the workers in a financial way to help them combat this disease, and we lead every state in the union in this respect. So while we are considering an employers' liability and compensation act, it seems an opportune time to consider this vital question, Germany has a workmen's insurance law, and from this we might find some practical plan to enact legislation.
