City Meeting Votes Total Appropriation of \$27,000—Eight and One-Half Mill Tax

All appropriations as estimated by the common council, including a special appropriation of \$4,500 for the purchase of a stone crusher and a road roller, were voted at the adjourned annual city meeting held in Hammond hall Monday evening.

There was some discussion relative to appropriating the \$4,500 asked for building machinery, the proposal being opposed by E. Child, who believed it would be cheaper for the city to hire a road roller in preference to buying one, and also that it would prove economical to buy stone for the street work by the ton rather than to crush the same.

On the other hand, he estimated that the Thompson roller, about hired for thirty days at the rate of \$100 per day, at the rate of \$5.50 a day, would be \$75, a total of \$75 fixed cost per year.

There was considerable further discussion on account of the street work, the meeting finally voting to make an appropriation and buy the crusher and roller.
