Waterboard Encounters Trouble in Settling for the Trading Cove Pipe Line—Pumping Station in Line of Brush Fire Contractors at Work on Pipeline.

There are three property owners on the Trading Cove brook line with whom the board of water commissioners are unable to reach an agreement as to a satisfactory price for allowing the laying of the pipe line across their land. In each case a price must be in excess of what the board considers a fair figure is wanted.

There was a conference between these owners and the board at the water office on Monday afternoon, but no terms could be agreed upon. The property in question is the Manwaring, Polsky and Pierson, the pipes being laid underground, and the trenches filled and leveled off so that there is no interference with any use of the land for the purposes it is regularly used for.

One of the owners, Mr. Pierson, was some sentiment in the matter which he considered raised the amount of the price to what it ordinarily would be. The conference lasted several hours, but was without result. No other matters came up for action at that time before the board.

Contractor Dodd commenced work on his contract on Monday and has a truck engaged in hauling material for his section of the job. A length of pipe, 24 inches in diameter is taken from the yard of the water board, and an hour is delivered along the line. They are not easily handled, because of their weight.

At the Huntington street station, where the pipe is unloaded from the boats, employees of the water department are present to receive the pipe, its size and to whom it is delivered. The pipe is tested as it leaves the yard.

cityward, the pipe being laid just outside the twelve-inch pipe which was recently put down and the trench is now nearly to Dunham street.

The Petrol company has erected shacks for the employees at the Stony brook site and were here on Monday.

The pumping station is kept at its steady 24 hours a day, and the water pumped into the system reduces the draft from Fenwick by one-half. This is a better pressure throughout the city and it is probable that this reduced the amount which would be required to pump the water. There is about 1,400,000 gallons of water used daily now, and only about 900,000 gallons of water is drawn from the reservoir, which maintains its highest mark this year, 135 feet above the Fenwick level.
