A BASEBALL WAR Without Fight by Eastern League—Magee Applies to National League Directors For Hearing—New Yorkers Win Longwood Tennis Finals.

New York, July 24.—Baltimore will not obtain a franchise in the National league without precipitating a baseball war between the leagues, according to Edward Barrows, president of the Eastern league, who issued a statement tonight criticizing certain members of the National league. President Barrows said he was "feeling pretty sore" over the manner in which Baltimore was induced to leave the Eastern league.

Barney Dreyfus, president of the Pittsburgh club of the National league, bought Martin O'Toole, St. Paul's spitball pitcher, Saturday, for \$22,500, the highest price in the history of organized baseball ever paid for a ballplayer.
