

2,515 PACKAGES IN SEVEN DAYS

Postmaster Caruthers Submits His First Report on Parcels Post—1405 Were Incoming and 1110 Outgoing—Norwich Protest is Effective in Having Restriction Removed Against Mailing Pistol Parts.

By a report just sent to Washington by Postmaster William Caruthers on the business done here for the first seven days of parcel post, it is shown that the Norwich office has handled a grand total of 2,515 packages.

The report covers the following items: Total number of local parcels delivered 20; average weight, 15 ounces; amount of postage by local parcels delivered, \$1.02; total number of incoming parcels delivered, 1,385.

On the outgoing side the items are as follows: Total number of outgoing parcels despatched, 1,110; average weight, 14 ounces; amount of postage on parcels despatched, \$80.84; total number of insured parcels despatched, 18; total number of insured parcels received for delivery, 25.

Pistol Parts Now Admitted. To the intervention of Postmaster Caruthers on behalf of the pistol factories of this city, they as well as all others in that line, have had the parcel post service made available to them for the sending of pistols in whole or in parts through the mail by parcel post.
