House Passes Good Roads Bill. Washington, Feb. 10.—The Shackleford bill, under which the federal government would distribute \$10,000,000 for good roads among the various states, conditioned upon a dollar for dollar appropriation by each state, was passed by the house today by vote of 282 to 42, and now awaits action by the senate.

Atchison, Kansas, has a cooking rate of five cents a kilowatt for those who want to install electric cooking devices in their homes.

Three firms have filed petitions in bankruptcy against the Wilcox company of Wakefield, manufacturing chemists. The petitioners are: a claim of \$276.92, the National Folding Box company of New Haven, with a claim of \$450.01, and Hanning and Blending, of a claim for \$37.92. It is alleged that the Wilcox company committed an act of bankruptcy which allowed a receiver to take charge of the affairs of the company by order of the superior court. The receiver was appointed Jan. 7 and is still in charge of the property and business of the concern.

John A. Farrell, of Westerly, appointed stamp duty collector for internal revenue, with station in Providence, to succeed Charles W. Murphy, who has been appointed to the position of collector of the preferred appointment and did not consider it essential to state the reason why. He talked over the situation with Collector James J. Welsh of Hartford, while in Providence and informed the collector that he did not care for the position. Just at this time he was notified that he had been appointed Deputy Collector Samuel W. Davis, is acting as stamp duty.

William T. Greene, treasurer of the Rhode Island Anti-Slavery league, has published his report for 1913, which shows that 148 churches gave \$674.87 and 715 donors gave \$2,341.74, a total of \$3,016.61. Of this sum the Congregational churches gave \$1,197.29, Baptist churches \$618.53, Free Baptist churches \$228.82, Christian Church \$43.30, Seventh-day Baptist \$75.15, Methodist \$315.12, Friends \$49.71, Episcopal \$171.57, Latter-Day Saints and Lutheran Swedish \$23.61, Pentecostal \$23.25, Presbyterian \$72.73, Primitive

Methodist \$5, Unitarian \$31, and Universalist \$122.

The contributions from Westerly churches were: First Baptist \$15.60, Calvary Baptist \$11.10, Seventh-day Baptist \$32.00, and Seventh-day Baptist of Ashaway \$25.00.

In the official organ of the league, this declaration is made: "There are many whose voices have been loudly raised in behalf of temperance work and saloon suppression in our state who have never been known to contribute to any of its various organizations for service."

The Equipment Fund of the Diocese will be the subject of discussion at the meeting next Wednesday evening of the Providence Churchmen's club. The special speaker will be Rt. Rev. Samuel G. Babcock, suffragan bishop of Massachusetts, a former resident of Westerly, who recently purchased The Dunes, a handsome Watch Hill cottage and property. Brief addresses will be made by Rt. Rev. De Wolf Perry, bishop of the Rhode Island Episcopal diocese, Rush Sturges, treasurer of the equipment fund and other prominent churchmen.

There was a shooting affray in the saloon of Natale Bemeruti in Canal street Tuesday evening, the assailant being Pasquale Salameno, a former town constable, and the victim, a bootblack, and who, up to the present time, has had a clean record. The man shot at was Charles Brown, better known as "Sandy" an occasional tough customer, and who several years ago struck the late Cornelius Bransfield, chief of police, in the head with a baseball bat. But this was one of the times when Sandy was not at fault.

There were several men in the saloon at the time of the shooting. Pasquale and Sandy got in a dispute. Pasquale abused Sandy and threatened to put him out of the place. He took hold of Sandy and tried to force him into execution. Sandy protested and then resisted, and Pasquale could not move him. Then Pasquale became angered and struck Sandy with the butt end of a revolver. Sandy then made a grab for Pasquale, who stepped backward, took aim at Brown and fired.

In an instant Pasquale was unarmed. Policeman Mitchell notified and Pasquale was arrested. Dr. Scaglion was summoned and made close examination of Brown and was surprised to find that Brown was not injured. The bullet had struck the neck, but was glancing shot, passing through Brown's coat, his padded vest and two shirts, grazing the flesh and entering the body. It was a miraculous escape for Brown, as a slight deviation of the aim would have caused the bullet to enter the body in a vital part.

Pasquale Salameno spent the night in the police station and will be arraigned in the Third district court Wednesday morning.

Westerly Learns Of Peckham Will

Long List of Bequests to Residents of Preston—\$500 to Brewster's Neck Cemetery—Montville Relative Remembered—Westerly First Baptist Church Benefits—John A. Farrell Declines Internal Revenue Appointment.

Judge Elias B. Hinckley of the Stonington probate court held a session in Pawtucket Tuesday afternoon, in his custom, for the accommodation of those interested in matters before the court in that section of the town of Stonington. The will of John Peckham, late of Pawtucket, which was admitted to probate, provides for the payment of \$500 to the Westerly Cemetery society for the care of the cemetery grounds. Provision is made for the erection of a monument in the Peckham lot at Brewster's Neck, to be of Westerly granite and to cost \$300, and to be erected on a strong foundation. The sum of \$300 is set aside for carrying to the burial lot, which is also to be of Westerly granite. The bodies of her father and mother are to be removed to the lot, and all graves there-in are to be bricked.
