CONSUL EAGER GODFATHER.

To First Full-Blooded American Indian Baby Ever Born in Germany—Odd Experience of Norwich Man.

United States Consul George E. Eager of Barmen, Germany, formerly of Norwich, whose wife was Miss Ruth Spalding of East Norwich, figured in an interesting ceremony July 4th. A special from Berlin to Tuesday's New York Times said:

The first full-blooded American Indian ever born in Germany has just seen the light of day near Dortmund, Westphalia. The child's father is a Sioux Indian from the Pine Ridge agency, William Bear Shield, and the mother is Mary Bear Shield. The father is now in America, but the mother is a member of an Indian troupe touring Germany with a circus.

The birth took place in a typical American prairie wagon while the troupe was en route from Dortmund to Recklinghausen.

The mother was anxious that her little papoose, which is a girl, should be duly registered in the German records as an American citizen and a Christian. To that end she sought the nearest American consul, George Eugene Eager, who represents the United States at Barmen.

The baby was born on June 29, but as the Fourth of July was approaching the baptism was deferred until then. Mr. Eager stood as godfather for the child, who was christened Maria Consula.

BRANDEGEE FOR THIRD TERM

Connecticut's Conservative Senator Has Personality Inviting to the Voters of the State, as Well as an Envious Record Behind Him, Writes Washington Correspondent—Fills Platt's Shoes.

Washington correspondent, John Loran, of the Boston Evening Record, writes the following interesting article on United States Senator Frank B. Brandegee of Connecticut:

New England will elect only three United States senators in the coming election, and the gratifying news received that Senator Brandegee is practically assured of being returned for a third term. Six months ago his prospects were not regarded as over bright, it was to be sure, true that he was certain of a nomination by the Republicans at the primaries and no one has since announced himself as a competing candidate but the Republican outlook at the time was not generally encouraging.

Business conditions have affected Connecticut industries hard, and this is expected to be a telling factor in the coming election in favor of the Republican ticket, and especially the senatorial sections of it, for in the canvass Senator Brandegee will present himself as a conservative, and a conservative is at that, one who has never changed his coat to serve a passing popular whim, and inasmuch as radicalism is blamed more than anything else for the present unsatisfactory business conditions, it is believed Senator Brandegee will look a very inviting personality to the voters of Connecticut with which to rebuke the proposals of radicalism.

Senator Brandegee is relatively a young man, capable of hard work, and a hard worker indeed, and an effective worker he has demonstrated.

He was called upon to fill the place of the great Senator Orville H. Platt, a trying proposition, and of course, at the time the senator suffered by comparison. But he has grown into the shoes of the departed senator with credit to expect, and he especially grew during the Taft administration when he was taken into the coteries of Republican leaders, and became a leader of them.

Today there is no man more influential member on the Republican side than Brandegee.

More recently he has faced greater opportunities, and has met them with power. Two years ago he represented the Panama canal tolls, and as a member of the interoceanic canal committee he was to the fore in supporting the repeal bill this year. This involved a great deal of work. He figured in the debates, and always contributed something new in the discussions and in an original way. But there was more work for him. He is a member of the Senate Commerce committee, and as such has figured in the discussion of the anti-trust program, and especially on the interstate trades commission bill and in the railroad securities bill.

FOR MORE PAY AND BETTER WORKING CONDITIONS

Grievance Committee of the Shore Line Trolleymen Confer With President Perkins.

A committee representing the union trolleymen of the Plant lines came to Norwich Monday and conferred with President Perkins of the Shore Line Electric company regarding wages and working conditions. Neither side would say what proposition the employees made to the management. The matter was taken under consideration and the committee was engaged until 10 o'clock Wednesday afternoon, at which further discussion of the proposition will take place, and there is a probability that answer will be made.

New London trolleyman, is chairman of the committee, William McDougal of East Lyme, Robert Donahue and Oscar Christianson of Norwich. John Cousins of the trolley line and John Allen of the Groton-Stonington line are Mr. Lewis' associates on the grievance committee.

TELEPHONE EMPLOYEES ORGANIZE

Eastern Connecticut Men in Mechanical Department Affiliate With Electrical Workers' Union.

Another accession to the forces of unionism in this section is stated to be the organizing of the employees of the Southern New England Telephone company in eastern Connecticut. It is understood that at least 100 out of the 150 workmen employed in the district have affiliated with the Electrical Workers' union. A meeting for the purpose of organization was held a few days ago in Norwich. While little was given out concerning the session, it was stated by a local telephone workman that the union was formed and that by virtue of the national bylaws it had to have 100 members to receive a charter.

Operators in the exchanges of the district are not included in the organization. Only those employed in the mechanical department are eligible. Eastern Connecticut is said to be the only section of the state in which the telephone employees were not organized before.

WEST POINT NEEDS 200 BOYS.

Many Cadetships to Be Filled by Appointment in 1915—Connecticut Boys Eligible.

Nearly 200 cadets are to be appointed to the West Point military academy in 1915. The examination of candidates appointed by senators and representatives will begin on the last Tuesday of March, 1915.

Appointments are to be made by senators from 27 states and by representatives from 31 states. The list of the states, with the names of the senators who are to make appointments includes: Connecticut, McLean and Brandegee.
