**GROWTH OF TOWN  
O CASABLANCA**  
Natives Marvel at the Zeal of German Prisoners of War.

Casablanca, Morocco, Aug. 16.—(Correspondence of The Associated Press).—Morocco, one of the biggest bones of contention between European powers, but lost to sight now in the general war, appears not to suffer from the neglect of diplomats. During the thick of the conflict French rule is developing its aim with rapidity.

Casablanca is building with the pace of a mushroom town of the west. In two years it has become a modern, model town with sewers, water, gas, electric lights, new quays, wharves and piers. This sudden growth of what in these parts is a town of skyscrapers awes and dominates the Moor, who watches it from his low gourbi or tent as though it were witchcraft. Yesterday where the vegetation of the west African coast grew a foot high there are broad avenues stretching far from the seashore. The natives lined up on either side look on lazily, marveling at the zeal of the German

prisoners-of-war putting the finishing touches to the pavements, and wondering for what it is all intended. Tomorrow more hotels, stores and villas will rise there, and as fast as the lots are taken up more avenues will be built. The town as now laid out would easily accommodate 200,000 inhabitants in addition to its regular population of 80,000. The smoking chimneys of a big cement works, erected to facilitate building, add one more to the many marvels that have worked upon the minds of the moors. So many of these marvels of French colonization have

they seen that the departure of a considerable portion of the French troops has not in the least diminished French prestige. On the contrary, the participation of a considerable contingent of Moroccan native troops in the fight so far away has made it in a way "their war," while the five thousand Germans brought here in captivity are looked upon with a sort of local pride as "our prisoners." There are many legends afloat as to the proportion of these men who were captured by Sidi Mohamed, by the Gaid El Hadj Kazan and other chiefs of the Moroccan "goumiers."

**TEN CALVES ADDED  
TO U. S. BISON HERD.**

Buffalo of Wichita National Forest Now Number 62 and Promise to Continue Increasing.

Washington, Aug. 16.—The government's herd of buffalo on the Wichita National Forest in Oklahoma, which is also a federal game preserve, has been increased by the arrival of ten calves, according to a report received by the Forest Service from the super-

visor in charge. The herd, which now comprises 52 specimens of the almost extinct bison, is in good condition, says the supervisor, and promises to continue increasing at a rapid rate. Eight of the calves are females, bringing the number of heifers and cows up to 30. The bulls number 22 and have been placed by themselves in a pasture which has just been fenced in for them. Three years ago the buffalo herd on the Wichita forest was little more than half as large as it is now. It is said that the other game animals in

the preserve, including the elk and antelope, also are increasing, due to the protection afforded, not only against hunters, but against wolves, wild cats and other predatory animals. Eight of the calves are females, which committed serious depredations from the establishment of the preserve in 1905 until measures were taken to stop them. In protecting the game from predatory animals the wardens and forest officers are also promoting the interests of local stock men, who graze several thousand head of cattle on certain allotted areas within the preserve.
