RED SOX HAVE GREAT OUTFIELD Boston Gardeners Appear to be Faster Than the Quakers' Trio-Speaker One of Greatest Batters and Speediest Outfielders in the Game-Cravath a Wonderful Stickler for Philadelphia.

Of the big series between the Red Sox and Quakers was to be determined solely on the respective merits of the rival outfields. The Boston team would have fairly easy sailing.

No one, not even the most rabid partisans of the National league team, will dispute this. For five seasons now the Red Sox outfield gardeners have been acclaimed the most wonderful outfield in either of the big leagues. Their power both on the offensive and defensive is simply wonderful.

All four of the Red Sox outfield, including the utility man Henriksen, have had experience in a world series fight. In the Philadelphia outfield but one man, Whitted, has been subjected to such a test, and he, alone, of all the Braves outfielders of last season, acquitted with credit.

From the viewpoint of experience alone, the Red Sox outfield, therefore, starts off with a decided advantage, and its superiority increases as each player is compared. Paskert is a clever outfielder, a fast man on the bases when he gets there, and his throwing arm is one of the best, but he falls manifestly in comparison with Tris Speaker.

Speaker, the star of the Boston outfield, is one of the greatest batters in the game standing well above 300 every year since he first made his major league debut. Paskert fails to come up to Speaker's value as a hitter by nearly 100 points, and aside from this, he fails to get on the bases nearly so often as the Texan. Time after time Speaker is purposely passed, while the National league pitchers seem to be in a hurry to get past Paskert.

Speaker Great Ground Coverer. Speaker plays the centre field position like an infielder. He gathers every bit of ground balls on the run, and his throwing to the bases or to the plate is fast and true. The greatest ground coverer of his time, he plays a short field, for his wonderful ability to go back and pull down long drives gives him a value such as no other middle gardeners possess.

Cravath Wonderful Clouter. Cravath will outdo Hooper by some 40 or 50 points, but Harry will get on the sacks nearly as often, as Hooper is a fine judge of balls and strikes, and he forces the National league pitchers to pitch to him. He is a timely, though not a hard hitter, and many a game this season has been won for Boston because Hooper was on deck with the needed punch.

Hooper will cover twice as much ground as Cravath; he will judge flies much better; his throwing is far more powerful and accurate than that of Cravath, and he never throws to the
