Mrs. Lily May Moran, East Killingly, was sentenced in the town court Tuesday morning to serve 30 days in jail and to pay a fine of \$10 and costs, the fine imposed on two counts of breach of the peace.

Health Officer Spalding Establishes a Quarantine in Woodstock Because of Suspicious Case—Town Clerk Flagg Wants to Be Probate Judge—Miss Hertz to Teach French and German, Miss McGarry, of Norwich, Kindergarten.

Dr. Joseph Spalding, health officer of the town of Woodstock, on Tuesday placed quarantine regulations in force there. Under these regulations, no children under the age of 16 will be permitted to enter the town unless in possession of acceptable health certificates from health officers of the town from which they come.

The action was taken following the development of a case that is under suspicion as infantile paralysis, but which Dr. Spalding hopes will prove to be pneumonia. The patient is Frederick Wilcox, 19, son of Eugene Wilcox. Sunday the young man's condition had become so serious that it was thought best to remove him to the Day Kimball hospital here, Monday, after a consultation of physicians, young Wilcox was sent back to Woodstock.

Dr. Spalding said Tuesday afternoon that the young man was taken to a cooling pool in the town of Woodstock. At the time he went in bathing the young man was in an over-heated condition. The first ill effect noticeable following his bath was a sore throat. Afterwards there were symptoms of pneumonia and the young man's condition gradually became serious. Finally he became so ill that it was decided best to send him to the local hospital, which was done.

Upon the young man's return to Woodstock, Dr. Spalding ordered that he be placed in quarantine, as a protective measure, and, as health officer, posted notices relative to children under 16 years of age coming into the town.

Tuesday morning the patient was in an unfavorable condition that he was able to leave his bed and walk about the house for a time, this, of course, he was not closely observed by those charged with seeing that he remained as quiet as possible. His activity was taken, however, as a good sign that he will recover.

The young man has been employed by his grandfather, Hector Wilcox, and, so far as is known, has not been exposed to the disease that is causing so much worry and discussion. Dr. Spalding says that there are a few out of town children in Woodstock, but there has been no illness among them.

ANNOUNCES HIS CANDIDACY FOR PROBATE JUDGESHIP. Town Clerk and Treasurer David Flagg Promises to Make Lively Canvass For Office.

Town Clerk and Treasurer David Flagg on Tuesday announced his candidacy for election as judge of probate in the district of Putnam. Mr. Flagg will seek the republican nomination for the office.

The office of judge of probate in Putnam became vacant last February upon the death of Judge Edward G. Wright, who had faithfully and successfully administered the duties of the office for a long period of years. Following Judge Wright's death there was some talk of holding a special election to name his successor, but it was finally decided to cite Judge Henry T. Child of the Woodstock court as acting judge for Putnam and he has since discharged the duties of the office.

The election of a judge, therefore, for a period of two years, will be one of the matters for the voters to decide at the election on November 7. The names of candidates for the office will appear on the state ticket.

Mr. Flagg has been clerk of the probate court for a period of 18 years, during all of the time that Mr. Wright filled the judgeship. In discussing his candidacy Tuesday afternoon, Mr. Flagg said that he believed that, in view of the fact that the office of the town clerk is now located in the municipal building on Main street and that he is required to be at the office six hours each day, it would be well that he also hold the office of judge of probate. The compensation that he receives as town clerk is not heavy, considering the time he is required to give to the duties of the office and the keeping of the records. By holding both offices, however, he feels that in such a case he would be able to give more adequate attention to the services performed.

Mr. Flagg says that he will be an active candidate. He has already talked with members of the republican town committee relative to receiving an endorsement in connection with a canvass for support. Mr. Flagg has made a record as a very efficient town clerk and his records are among the best kept in the state. He has introduced and personally maintained a typewritten record of all business with his regard as among the model sets in town clerk's records in Connecticut.

How Lucian Andrews Met Death. The body of Lucian Andrews, 10, killed in an automobile accident at Norwich, Mass., was brought to Putnam. The little fellow was struck by a machine while he was crossing a road near the company with his cousin. His injuries were not at first regarded as very serious, but death followed a short time, due to internal hemorrhages.
