COMPENSATION FOR 78 WEEKS Agreement Reached Between Carl Yetki and Glen Woolen Mills at Hearing Before Commissioner Donohue—William Lazar Must Undergo Operation or Forfeit Claim for Compensation.

On Wednesday Compensation Commissioner James J. Donohue announced his finding in the case of Carl Yetki of Norwich Town, claimant, against the Glen Woolen mills of Norwich Town. The hearing was held in his office in the Central building on Monday at 1.30 o'clock in the afternoon at which time the following facts were found: On June 7th the claimant had his left hand caught in a carding machine, injuring the tendons on the back of his left hand, the injury extending up into his wrist. The injury was the result of an accident in the course of his employment. On July 29th a voluntary agreement was affected by the receipt of one misappreciated bone and that a distal portion of this bone is at an angle of perhaps 45 degrees from the rest of the bone and the surgeon suggested that unless the claimant received further treatment this condition would interfere with the full use of his hand.

Commissioner Donohue has also announced his finding in the case of William Lazar of Killingly, claimant against the Killingly Manufacturing company of Killingly. The hearing was held on Monday afternoon at two o'clock when the following facts were found: On the 13th of June the claimant sustained an injury to the right hand by a fracture of one of the metacarpal bones of his right hand, the injury being caused by his left hand being caught between a belt and a pulley and it arose out of and in the course of his employment.
